



Tommerup Public Library, Denmark



Tommerup Public library is placed in Fyrtårn Tommerup, the city's new culture and sports centre. The organic forms of the building invite the surrounding forest with large and arched window sections.

The interior designer, Lykke Jørgin, has used the nature as focal point of the interior decoration of the library. For example, specially designed furniture in ash are placed along the window sections with full utilization of the daylight. A custom-made viewing platform covered with felt gives the possibility of looking at the nature at close range. The green colours of the nature have been dragged into the library and interact well together with the additional yellow and orange colours.

A large custom-made play-sit furniture with integrated browsers for display of children's books can be found in the children's zone. Wall mounted shelving systems in staggered heights add dynamic to the room. Mobile orange display elements are placed in the shelving system to generate attention to selected topics or to create smaller exhibitions.

The smart and flexible information counters are custom-made.
